27 singers selected for the preliminary competition of the Toivo Kuula Singing Competition 2025

The video qualification phase of the Toivo Kuula Singing Competition has concluded, and 27 singers have been chosen to advance to the preliminary round. A total of 84 applicants from nine countries participated in the qualifying round.

The chair of the jury, **Kirsi Tiihonen**, praised the high standard of the participants and noted the strong international interest in the competition. She highlighted the exceptional representation of low voices compared to previous years. Alongside Tiihonen, the jury included **Jaakko Ryhänen**, **Mari Palo**, and **Sirkka Lamminen**, all of whom emphasized the importance of overall performance, text interpretation, and emotional expression.
